Things to remember in Year One:

- Year 1 PE is on a Thursday. PE kit is to be kept in a bag in school.
- I have a new reading book once a week. I must bring my reading book and Reading Record in EVERY DAY.
- I get KUNCU homework when needed to help me keep up with the lessons . This needs to be returned as soon as possible so that the children can access the next lesson.

Learning in Year One:

In writing





We will learn how to say, sequence and write instructions for everyday processes such as washing our hands and cooking.

<u>Fiction</u> - We will read and learn stories with familiar settings like No David by David Shannon. We will have a go at writing our own simple story with a different character.

Poetry - We will write descriptive poems about fireworks night.

- We will learn to recognise and read tricky words
- We will talk about what we have read and learn how to retell stories in the correct order and find information in non—fiction books




We will be learning.......

Shape: know names of 2D & 3D shapes and describe some properties




