

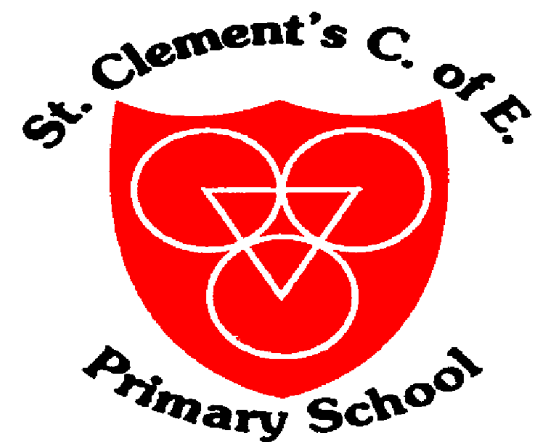
Things to remember in Year 4:

- I have guided reading every day and I need to remember to bring in my book and reading record and any reading homework.
- I have PE on Thursday afternoon, so will come to bring my PE kit to school, or leave it in school.
- I have swimming on **Friday morning**.
- The expectation in Year 4 is that **everyone** will read for at least 15 minutes **every day**. This is **my homework every night**. My reading record needs to be in school every day and will be checked. If I have read I may receive CLEMs to spend in the CLEMs shop and get a dip in the box on Friday.
- Additional homework (KUNCU) may be sent. This will need to be returned in time for the next lesson (usually the next day). This is to help me keep up in lessons and make good progress.

Learning in Year 4:

- Spelling continues to be a focus as we move into Spring term. Children can practise their five key spelling words.
- In Year 4 the children have a national test on their time tables. Please continue to help your child to learn these up to 12 x 12. This does not have to be done online—writing tables, drawing pictures, having a quiz are also really useful ways of learning tables. Home work books can also be used for tables practice.
- Children have access to our class library at school and may change their library book as often as they wish. In addition, they will receive a new guided book every week, or two weeks depending on the length of the book . Please ensure that all school reading books are returned to school.
- Our new topic for Spring is the Ancient Greeks. There are a wide range of homework activities for the children that we will send home before Christmas. This will include looking at where Greece is in the world. What the weather and climate is like there. Finding out facts and information about Ancient Greek people.
