

Things to remember in Year Three

- We have PE twice a week—Tuesdays and Wednesdays and we need to make sure we bring in our complete P.E kits. This should be: red t-shirt, blue shorts with a plain tracksuit (preferably black) for colder weather. These should be kept in school where possible.
- Children will be sent home with KUNCU homework as and when necessary—however if this is not sent home we do expect children to be reading and practicing times tables or spellings every night.
- We will be bringing a book home from our class library regularly. However, please make sure you are reading a range of texts and record what you are reading in your Record books. It is important we are reading regularly, as remember—just 6 minutes a day can make a massive difference. Children are responsible for their own reading records and completing them

Learning in Year Three:

In Writing we are going to be developing our vocabulary skills in order to be able to select the most impactful language for writing for a variety of purposes. In Summer we'll be focusing on descriptive language, including Setting and Character—so get your children describing! What do they notice around them?

In Guided Reading: Reading is incredibly important in Year 3 and we will be continuing to monitor and discuss reading habits of the children, including Reading Records. Every Friday morning, we have Book Talk where we talk about what we are reading and also swop our books if we want to change them. In our guided reading lessons we'll be continuing our focus on inference and retrieval, whilst working on prediction and definition to help us understand and develop our own writing.

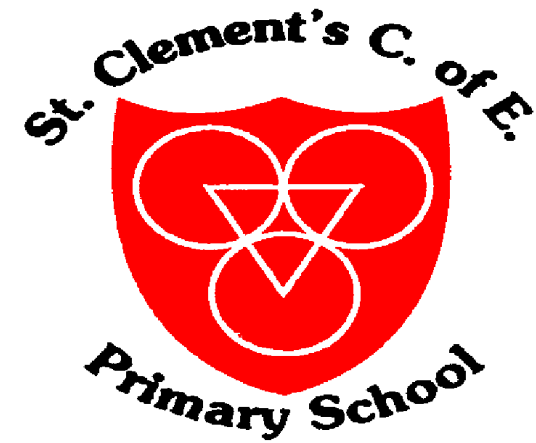
In Numeracy we will be revisiting different methods for addition and subtraction to ensure that everyone is confident with these skills. We are also developing our skill and confidence with multiplication and division. In order to be able to do this everyone needs to have secure knowledge of all multiplication facts.
